Course Description: The PIPP course provides planning and management level responders with the knowledge to effectively plan and prepare for a pandemic influenza event. The training provided by the Center for Domestic Preparedness (CDP) is guided by the definitions and competencies provided within the *National Response Plan (NRP)*, the *National Strategy for Pandemic Influenza (NSPI)*, and the *HHS Pandemic Influenza Plan (PIP)*.

After receiving instruction in pandemic influenza, planning and management level responders are then able to apply their knowledge in a practical exercise conducted in small groups where they assume community roles, develop plans, and participate in a simulated outbreak of pandemic influenza in a city of about 176,000 residents.
